DOOR FEES FOR PAID ENTERTAINMENT

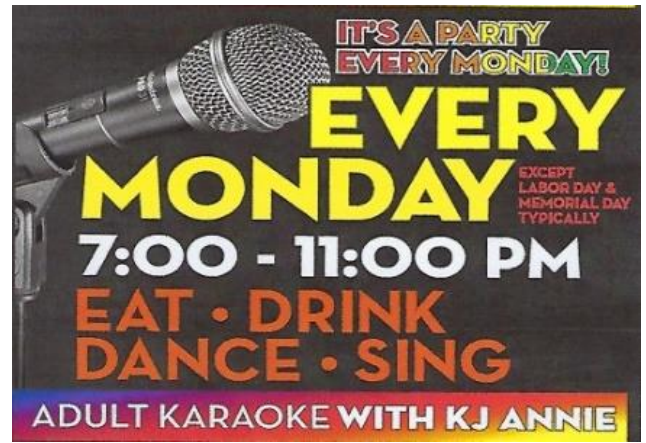
It has come to the point where we have to charge our door fees when we have to pay for entertainment.

Effective June 1st, 2021, Tuesday, there will be a \$5 cover charge for paid live entertainment in the lounge. Members of the Post 7 American Legion, Auxiliary Unit 7, S.A.L. Squadron 7, veterans who are members of other American Legion Posts, veterans who are members of other veterans' organizations and active-duty military are exempt from the cover charge.

There will be a \$10 cover charge for paid live entertainment in the Hall on Saturday nights. Members of the Post 7 American Legion, Auxiliary Unit 7, S.A.L. Squadron 7, veterans who are members of other American Legion Posts, veterans who are members of other veterans' organizations and active-duty military get 50% off, and only pay \$5 as they have in the past.
