Contest Rules

Essay entry must include:

A Title page with subject, date written, student's name, address, and grade. Each subsequent page must include the student's name in the upper right-hand corner and a page number at the bottom center of the page.

Ancestor may be a parent, grandparent, or any ancestor. Step and adopted ancestors are permitted, as are other relatives and friends and/or acquaintances.

The essay shall be at least 200 but no more than 500 words in length, not counting title, heading and page numbering. The essay may be either typed or handwritten in ink on 8 ½" x 11" paper or on plain white paper or regular theme paper with 1-inch margins. No decorative borders, pictures, or other graphics. If typed or printed, a 12- or 13-point **Times** or **Courier** typeface **MUST** be used. For reference, this document is 8 ½" by 11", 1-inch margins, and uses only "Times New Roman" and "Courier New" typefaces. The use of **bold**, <u>underline</u>, <u>and/or</u> italics for effect is acceptable. Emailed Entries must be in Microsoft® Word, Adobe® PDF, or Rich Text Format.

Partisan politics will disqualify an entry.

to consecrate and sanctify our friendship, by our devotion to mutual helpfulness;

to adopt in letter and spirit, all of the great principles for which The American Legion stands;

and to assist in carrying on for God and Country.
